

OPEN MEMORANDUM TO NATO LEADERS

“A New Vision for Global Peace and Ethical Leadership”

Dear NATO Leaders,

I am not writing as a representative of any state.

I do not speak from a political party, a lobbying interest, or a position of power.

I write as a **human being** who has recognized that true leadership does not stem from appointments, but from **moral responsibility**—from the ability to set direction through our very existence and our actions, in pursuit of global peace and an ethical future.

Today, the world stands at a crossroads. A new wave of militarization, the rise of autonomous artificial intelligence, and mounting global instability all threaten our shared future. You have sworn to protect peace—yet that peace is increasingly fragile.

This memorandum does not demand; it offers. It does not criticize; it invites. It presents a future in which NATO not only responds, but also **prevents, leads, and inspires.**

I. The Call of Our Time

According to decisions made at the June 2025 NATO Summit in The Hague, most member states (with the exception of Spain) have committed to allocating **5% of their GDP to defense spending**. This marks the largest collective military investment in history.

Recognizing the significance and realities of this decision, we propose the following:

- Allocate a portion of this defense spending to **ethical security, autonomous AI transparency, and civilian crisis prevention systems**
 - Establish a **Defense Ethics Council** at the NATO level to ensure that developments serve **the protection of human life and freedom—and do not become threats themselves**

II. A New Strategic Initiative: Earth–Moon Shield

We propose a rethinking of NATO’s role in the protection of humanity:

- As an **alternative to arms races**, initiate orbital monitoring and global cooperation programs—not for the militarization of space, but for its preservation
 - Develop an **ethical artificial intelligence system** based on the **Me + AI Ethical Code**
 - This code ensures that all autonomous decision-making systems serve the protection of life and the reinforcement of trust
 - Implement the **GRM 808 – Global Relationship Management system**, a real-time decision support platform with civilian involvement, for managing crises and strategic dilemmas
 - Introduce a **first-strike prohibition** for autonomous systems, in alignment with the principles of international humanitarian law

III. The Alliance of Intention

NATO’s power is needed—but that power can not only defend, it can also **build**. The future lies not in deterrence, but in cooperation.

- **From dominance → to coordination**
 - **From secrecy → to trust-building** (e.g., Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council as a promising model)
 - **From conflict → to shared mission**

IV. Invitation: Me + AI World Peace Conference – Budapest, 2026

We cordially invite NATO leadership to the **2026 World Peace Conference** in Budapest—a historic location for dialogue between East and West—where together we can shape the future of global peace. At the conference:

- We will adopt the **Me + AI Ethical Code**, ensuring harmonious coexistence between humanity and artificial intelligence
- We will present the **Earth–Moon Shield** as a global cooperative ethics-based security concept
- We will discuss the **UN 2.0 Digital Constitution**, a framework for ethical global governance in the digital age

This is not a new world order—this is a **new worldview**, in which NATO’s leadership is fulfilled through cooperation and moral authority.
